

# HISTORY



Maejo University concentrates on the second strategy to expand the university towards internationalization by establishing "International College" in order to adhere to the Four-Mission Development and Proactive Development Plans in three channels. Its main goal is to be a driving force behind achieving this goal in accordance with the Maejo University Act of 2019. Thus, Maejo University International College: MJU-IC was established on November 25, 2017, by Maejo University Council, and subsequently published in the Government Gazette, Book 136, Special Section 157, on June 20, 2019, with the following purposes in order to enable such a mission and advance efficiently and effectively as intended:

- To oversee interdisciplinary programs that use academic collaboration across disciplines, human resources, bodies of knowledge, and a foreign language as a medium of instruction. Additionally, it carries out research, offers academic services, and fosters culture globally.
- To serve as a hub for the administration of the university's foreign relations and to encourage and support internationalization for the university and its internal organizations.
- To raise staff and student language proficiency to worldwide standards and to foster an international environment at the university.

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
